SUMMARY

The Family Investment Administration (FIA) has secured a waiver to continue to waive interviews for Expedited SNAP (xSNAP) applications if identity has been verified. The waiver will remain in effect until September 30, 2022.

This IM revises the waiver timeline outlined in the Postponed Expedited Interview Waiver portion of the <u>AT 22-11 -Discontinuation-of-Interview-Waiver</u>.

Interviews are required for regular <u>SNAP applications as well as TCA and TDAP applications</u>.

With the xSNAP waiver extension, Case Managers will not require households eligible for xSNAP application processing to complete an interview before benefit approval if the applicant's identity has been verified and the Case Manager made an attempt to contact the applicant. *Case Managers must validate the contact attempt with narration and timely action*.

Case Managers are expected to review each SNAP application the agency receives within 24 hours of receipt and confirm if the customer meets the expedited criteria. If expedited criteria are met, the Case Managers must process the application and ensure the SNAP benefits are made available to the customer's EBT card on or before the 7th day after the application date. If the expedited criteria are not met, the SNAP application will remain pending until mandatory verifications are received on or before the 30th day of the application.
