



COMING SUMMER 2024 MARYLAND SUN BUCKS!

Maryland SUN Bucks helps families with school-aged children buy groceries when school meals aren't available. Families get \$40 per month for June, July and August (a total of \$120) for each eligible student.



GOOD NEWS!

A school-aged child is eligible for benefits under the Maryland SUN Bucks program if they:

- applied for and received free or reduced-price meals during school year 2023-2024,
- are 5-18 years old and their household gets SNAP, TCA, or Medicaid benefits, or
- are in foster care.

CHILDREN ENROLLED AUTOMATICALLY IF:

- their household participates in SNAP, Temporary Cash Assistance, or Medicaid;
- their household has applied for and received Free and Reduced School Meals during SY 2023-2024; or
- the children are in foster care, homeless, migrant, or runaway.

These households do not need to apply!

FAMILIES NEED TO APPLY IF A CHILD:

- is enrolled in a Community Eligibility Program (CEP) school that automatically receives Free and Reduced School Meals;
- is not actively receiving SNAP, Temporary Cash Assistance, or Medicaid; and
- is not in foster care.

The child's parent/guardian will have to apply and be determined eligible to enroll in the Maryland SUN Bucks program. Families must apply by August 31, 2024, to receive benefits for the summer of 2024.
